WHAT IS COCOA COMPASS?

Cocoa Compass is our ambition to make the future of cocoa more sustainable. A future where farmers are earning a living income, child labor is eliminated, and the natural world is protected. It sets challenging goals for 2030 and builds on nearly two decades of supporting cocoa-growing communities around the world.

WHAT PROGRESS ARE WE MAKING?

From distributing 1.75 million trees and extending our digital Child Labor Monitoring and Remediation Systems app (CLMRS), to developing a model to better understand and close living income gaps for farmers.

We made headway in 2020/21 across our three pillars of **Empowered to Grow**, **Focused on Farmers**, and **Investing in Nature**.

This latest progress is underpinned by the support of our customers and partners. And the achievement of our 2020 milestones, which means we have 100% traceability and deforestation monitoring in our direct global supply chain¹, and child labor monitoring in our managed sustainability programs.

EMPOWERED TO GROW



- Eliminate child labor from our supply chain.
- Help all children of cocoa farmers in our supply chain access education.

FOCUSED ON FARMERS



- Improve cocoa farmer livelihoods.
- Support 150,000 (60,000 by 2024) farmers in our supplier network to achieve a defined living income level, not just lift them out of poverty.

INVESTING IN NATURE



- Protect forests through a net increase in tree carbon stock.
- Mitigate our environmental impact through a 30% (10% by 2024) reduction in natural capital costs.
